



Billionaires in space

In light of the recent space flight by both Richard Branson and Jeff Bezos we want to share some information with you on both their companies and the private space industry as a whole. This is the second edition in the series and it is about Blue Origin.

Overview

Blue Origin is a company founded by Jeff Bezos. Blue Origins mission is to bring people and cargo into space quickly and cheaply. The flight lasts about eleven minutes and you can experience about 4-5 minutes of weightlessness. The flight is on their inhouse rocket New Shepard4(the fourth version). This launches from Launch Site One in Texas. The capsule has the largest windows to ever go to space and has no pilots. In the first manned launch of New Shepard there were four passengers: Jeff Bezos, his brother, 82-year-old Wally Funk and Dutch teen Oliver Daemen. Wally funk had trained as an astronaut in the apollo/mercury days to prove that women could pass NASA's strict standards. Unfortunately, they did not let her in because at that time NASA only allowed men to go into space but now her dream has come true and she is the oldest person to go to space. Oliver Daemen's family had bought the ticket from its previous owner and gave it to him as a high-school graduation gift, he is now the youngest person to go into space. History

In 2000 Jeff Bezos founded Blue Origin to chase down his childhood dream of having people work and live in space. He then found an area in Texas and bought it to be their launch site called Launch Site One. The first successful rocket they made was called Goddard named after Robert Goddard a rocket scientist. It was a proof of concept. It first launched on November 13, 2006 and has been retired. They worked for years and made New Shepard which has had 14 test flights some of them with cargo. They have plans to build an even bigger rocket called New Glenn that will be able to be reused 25 times.

How It Works

New Shepard launches using one rocket engine. They can do this because it is a much lower flight then an orbital flight. When the rocket gets close to the Karman line (the widely recognized boundary of Space) it will detach the capsual. The capsual has have momentum and will go above the line and that's when they will experience micro gravity. The capsual will travel far then land using parachutes to slow it down then at the lat second before imact tiny rockets ingnite slowing it down for tuchdown. The rocket will have droped already and landed verticly using fins to control it's angle and where it's going and a rocket to slow it down then it will land on it's legs.
